TRIVANDRUM ARTHROPLASTY COURSE (TAC 2017)

The second edition of Trivandrum Arthroplasty Course (TAC 2017), was conducted at The Hilton Garden Inn from 12 - 14 May 2017. Over 170 delegates registered for this conference and it was well attended by state and national faculty. The topics for discussion were carefully selected and handled by 25 faculty members who are experts in their field and stand shoulder to shoulder with the best in the world. Their execution of 9 live surgeries that represented diverse joint pathologies, significantly increased the knowledge base of attending delegates. The high definition real time interactive streaming of the live surgeries from SK Hospital to The Hilton Garden Inn gave delegates an unmatched "in-theatre" experience.

In addition, surgeries done live at international centres - robotic hip surgery by Dr. Ross Crawford from Australia and PCK knee from USA by Dr. Mark Munro, represented truly bleeding edge technology being applied to the medical field. There were a total of 11 live surgeries in a 3 day event. While this was a challenge for the organising committee, the organizing committee comprising Dr. Kailas Viswanath (Chairman), Dr. Ramakrishnan S (Secretary), Dr. Shanavas E K, Dr. Harish Chandran and Dr. Sudhir S Pai pulled it off without any glitches.
