PRESIDENTIAL MESSAGE

Esteemed members of Kerala Orthopaedic Association,

Some of our colleagues have left for heavenly abode since our last executive including one of our past President and we all are greatly bereaved by their untimely demise. I on behalf of KOA place on record our great grief and anguish.

Rising to the occasion, we could conduct our annual conference on a virtual platform, thanks to the untiring efforts of our Secretary and the vibrant scientific committee headed by Dr.Vijaymohan and Registration committee lead by Dr.Sudheer Sherief. The new executive committee took over and I welcome all the new members who have been installed in the executive committee, obtaining decisive mandate.

Last year, several of our members had succumbed to tragedies and ailments and our esteemed body had courageously came out with monetary aid to them. Though this was a great gesture, continued contributions of that sort seriously hampers the economic health of our Association. It is in this context that we have taken up our new venture, **The KOA Benevolent Fund.** The GB during KOACON2021 and subsequent executive committee meeting have approved the creation of this fund accepting a contribution of Rs. 1000 from each member and subsequent yearly contributions of RS.500/-. I request all life members of KOA to make this contribution if not already done.

We had the first executive committee meeting in February 2021, at Thrissur, a physical meeting and the Second meeting at Kochi on 27.06.2021. I had the occasion to visit the District Club Meetings of Thrissur and Cochin but therafter the Second wave of "Pandemic"shut the doors for any further club visits or direct interactions. I hope that I will be able to have my presence in other clubs also over this year.






