The 43rd Annual Conference of the Kerala Orthopaedic Association (KOACON 2024) was held at Back Water Ripples, Kumarakom from January 26th to 28th, 2024. The event was hosted by the Central Travancore Orthopaedic Society (CTOS). Dr. Tomichan served as the Organizing Chairman and Dr. Rajesh V. as the Organizing Secretary.

On January 26th, the Dr. P.A. Alexander Memorial Continuing Medical Education (CME) session was conducted, focusing on the topic of "Intraarticular Fractures." The CME was inaugurated by Dr. Tajan P.J., President of KOA, and featured contributions from various eminent faculty members who shared their knowledge, views, and expertise in their respective fields.

The conference inaugurated by Shri. V.N. Vasavan, Minister for Sports & Co-operation. During the inauguration, KOA Hon. Secretary Dr Antony J Thoppil presented the Annual Report, followed by a presidential address delivered by Dr. Tajan P.J. The keynote address was given by Dr. C.P. Vijayan, Pro Vice Chancellor (KUHS). Felicitations were offered by Dr. Aneen N. Kutty, Dr. Jiju A. Nuuman, Dr. Mathew K.M., and Dr. Georgy J. Kuruvilla.

The conference saw participation from approximately 600 delegates, contributing to the success and academic enrichment of KOACON 2024. The KSMC allotted 4.5 hours of CME credit for the conference.

POTCON2024: (BASIC Knee Scopy)



The additional CME under the aegis of KOA and AASK, POTCON – 2024, on Basic Knee Arthroscopy was held on 11th February, 2024 at Sapphire Hall, Malabar Medical College Hospital, Ulliyeri Kozhikode.

The meeting was inaugurated by KOA President, Prof. Aneen N Kutty in the presence of AASK President Dr Schiller Jos, AASK Secretary Dr Sujit Jos, Caos President Prof. Jacob, CaOS Secretary Dr. Abdul Gafoor, MMC Chairman Mr. Anil Kumar, Principal of MMC Prof. P V Narayanan, HOD of Orthopaedics Prof M K Ravindran.

Dr Jipin Gopi started the meeting with describing the Course Objectives. Four Live Surgeries were conducted – two cases of ACL reconstruction (with adjustable loop, and with fixed loop) including Meniscal Balancing, Meniscal Repair in a case of discoid Lateral Meniscus with tear, and PCL and PLC reconstruction. Eminent faculties from National and State levels shared their knowledge with delegates who have come from all of South Indian States. The academic sessions were on Understanding the Basics of Arthroscopy of knee, ACL reconstruction Didactics, Meniscal Repair Didactics and Case discussion on complex issues which included Ramp lesions, root repair.




