## ELIGIBILITY

- All candidates should be KOA and IOA life members . Maximum age limit to contest is 65 years for all posts except President Elect. There won't be any upper age limit for the post of President Elect.
- President Elect should be more than 55 years of age with 10 years KOA membership and 2 years of KOA Executive Committee membership.
- Vice President should be more than 50 years of age with 10 years KOA membership and 2 years of KOA Executive Committee membership.
- Associate Editor preferably should have at least 5 publications in pubmed / indexed journals and experience as assistant editor of KJO. )
- Vice President OASIS will subsequently become Senior Vice President and then President of OASIS. Elections to this post will be conducted when Kerala's turn comes once every 6 years. The applicant must be Past President or Past Secretary of KOA or Past Secretary General of OASIS
- One member can propose or second only one person during election process including nomination in the Annual General Body Meeting for vacant seats, if any.
- Executive Committee Members who do not have at least 50% attendance in the executive Committee meetings will not be eligible to be elected to any other post of KOA for the next 5 years. (Executive committee membership prior to five Years is valid)
- No Member can offer himself for re-election to the same post
- All nominations should be forwarded by the respective district club President / Secretary.

## KOA Benevolent Fund ( KOA KBF)

The KOA Benevolent Fund (KOA-KBF), with a total of 1,084 members, has shown consistent growth and community support over the years.

From 2021 to 2025, the fund collected a total of ₹12,23,500 through member contributions and club donations—₹4,31,000 in 2021 (431 members), ₹32,500 in 2022 (34 members), ₹1,92,500 in 2023 (112 members and contributions from Palakkad ₹1,00,000, Malappuram ₹15,000, and Pathanamthitta ₹10,000), ₹2,61,000 in 2024 (517 members), and ₹3,06,500 in 2025 (613 members).

During this period, several claims were disbursed, totalling an amount of ₹ 14,18,000 in claims.

Despite the high disbursement, the KOA-KBF maintains a healthy balance of ₹5,23,500, and 2 fixed deposit at Federal Bank, reflecting strong financial management and the spirit of solidarity among KOA members.
